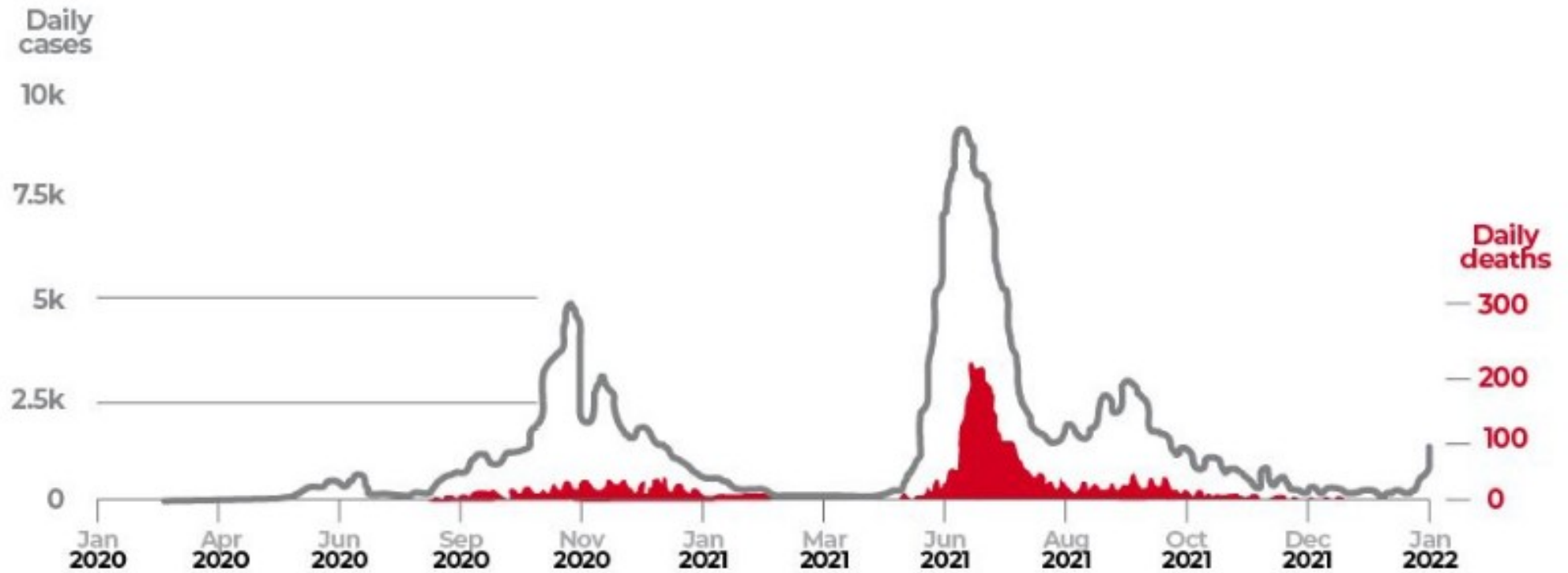
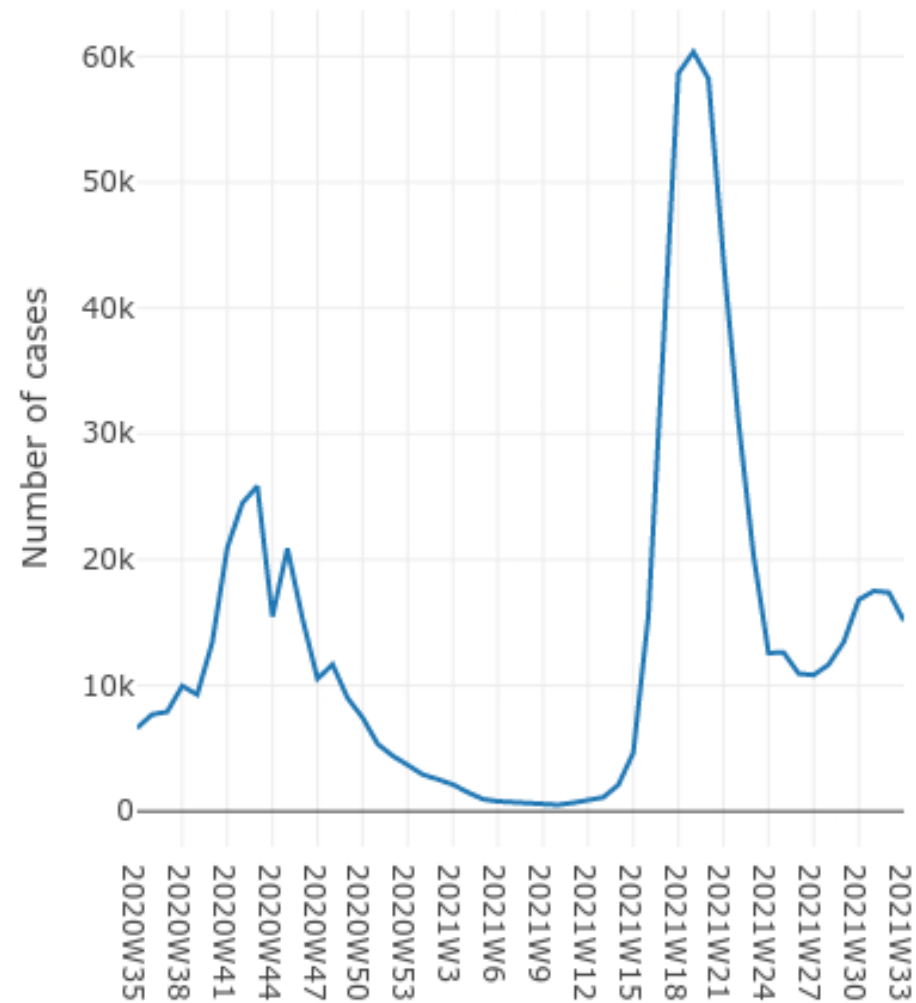

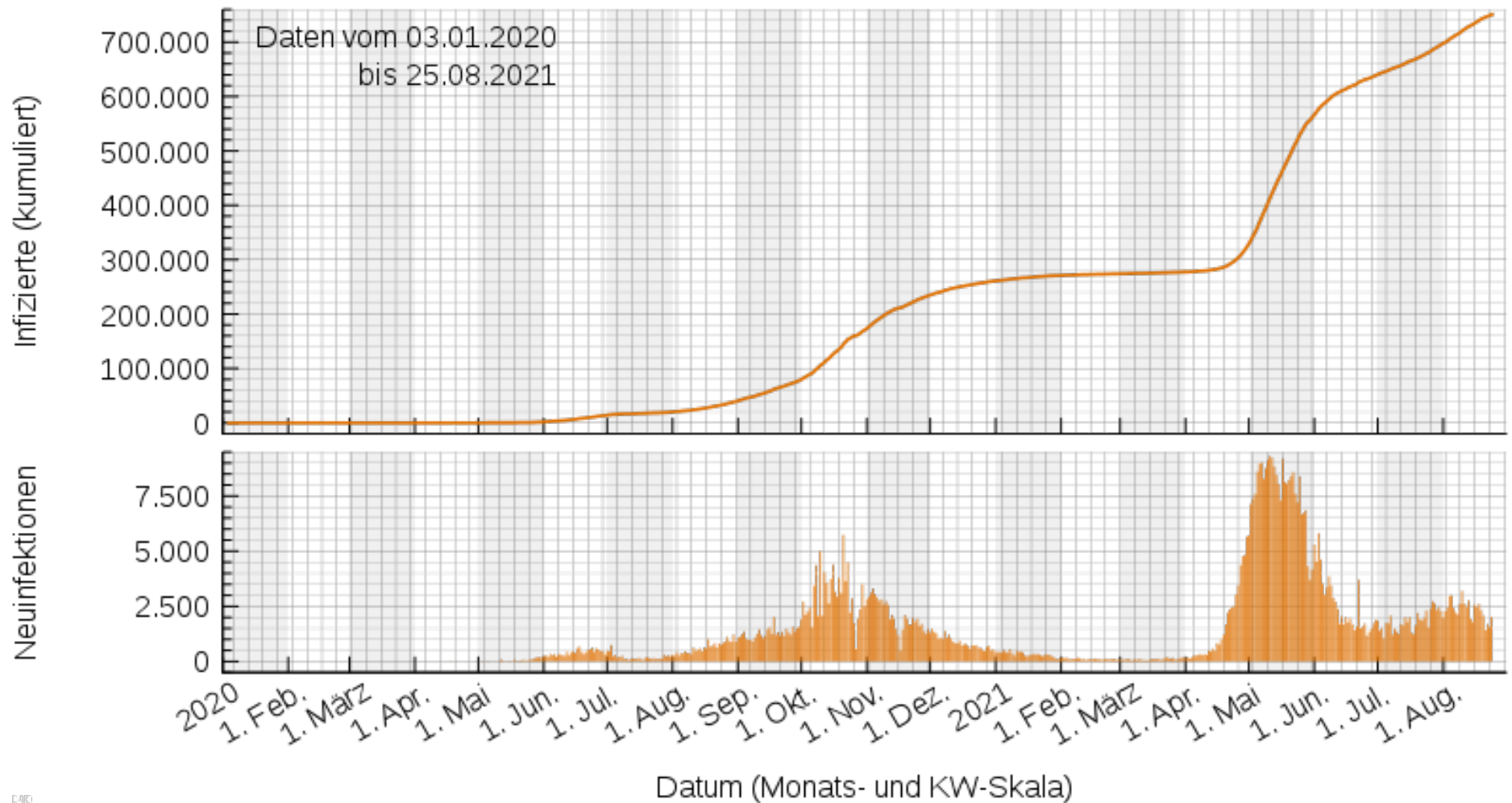


## Covid-19 cases (waves 1 and 2)

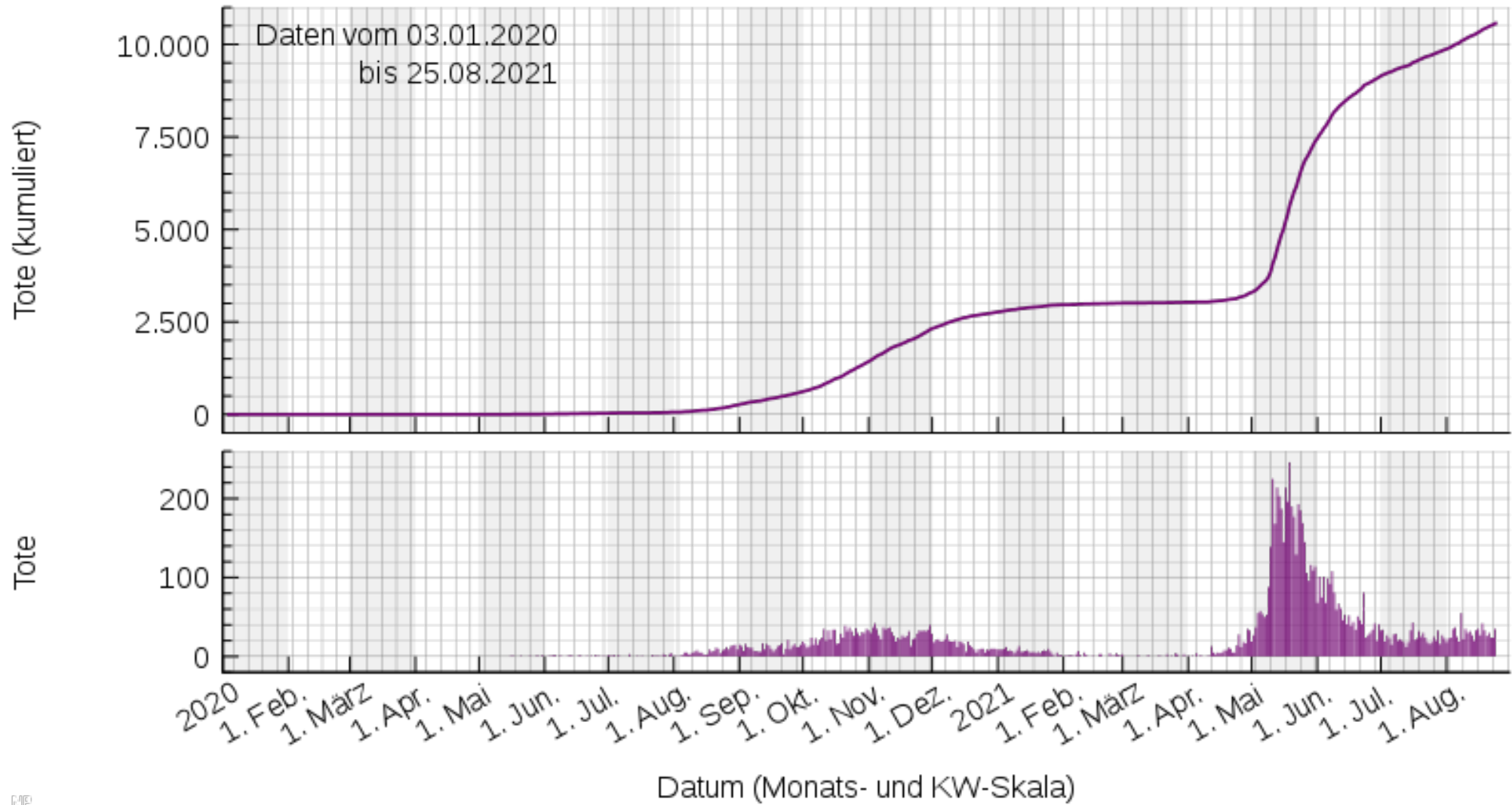
Cases by Cases reported by week

## **Political shortcomings**

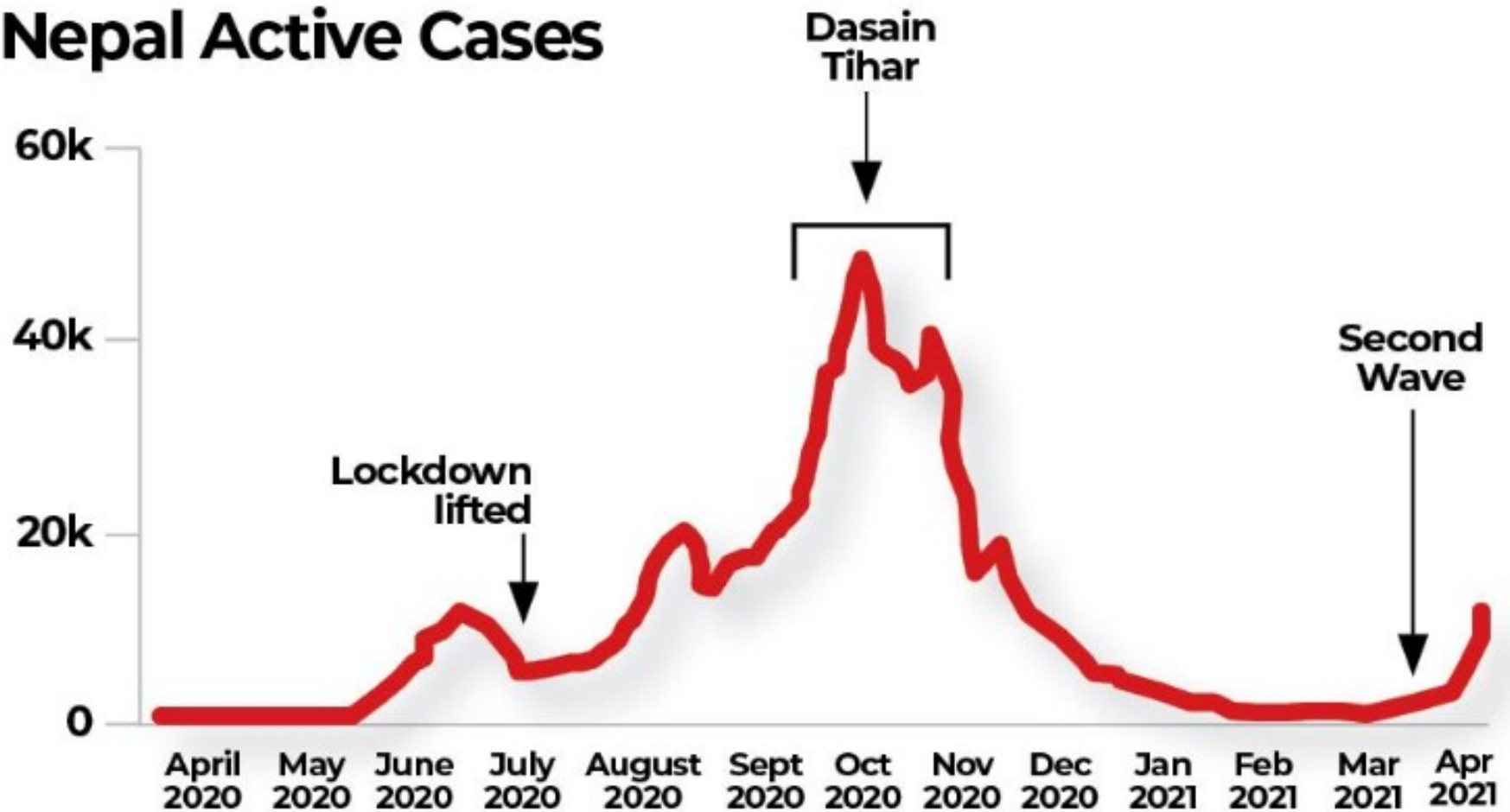
- hard lockdown without accompanying measures
- countrywide suspension of transport
- people confined to their homes
- chance to buy food in vicinity (6-8 in the morning)
- no chance to pursue professional activities
- day labourers hit hard: no job, no money for rent, no chance to go to villages
- no state support for people in need; support by some NGOs
- agriculture allowed but no transport to markets and consumers
- instead: increased food imports from India for urban areas
- complete cessation of international air traffic
- millions of labour migrants who lost their jobs in host countries could not return
- closure of Indian border: Nepali citizens were not allowed to enter their country
- many crossed the border secretly and walked to their villages
- persons apprehended were punished or detained by the police

## **Medical shortcomings**

- lack of test kits and laboratories
- as a consequence: people had to wait for results up to 14 days
- in the beginning only rapid tests (RDT) instead of PCR tests
- a limited number of quarantine centres with only poor infrastructure
- as a consequence: quarantine centres became breeding ground for the virus
- many infected persons left quarantine centres

Due to limited testing and challenges in the attribution of the cause of death, confirmed deaths can be lower than the true number of deaths.

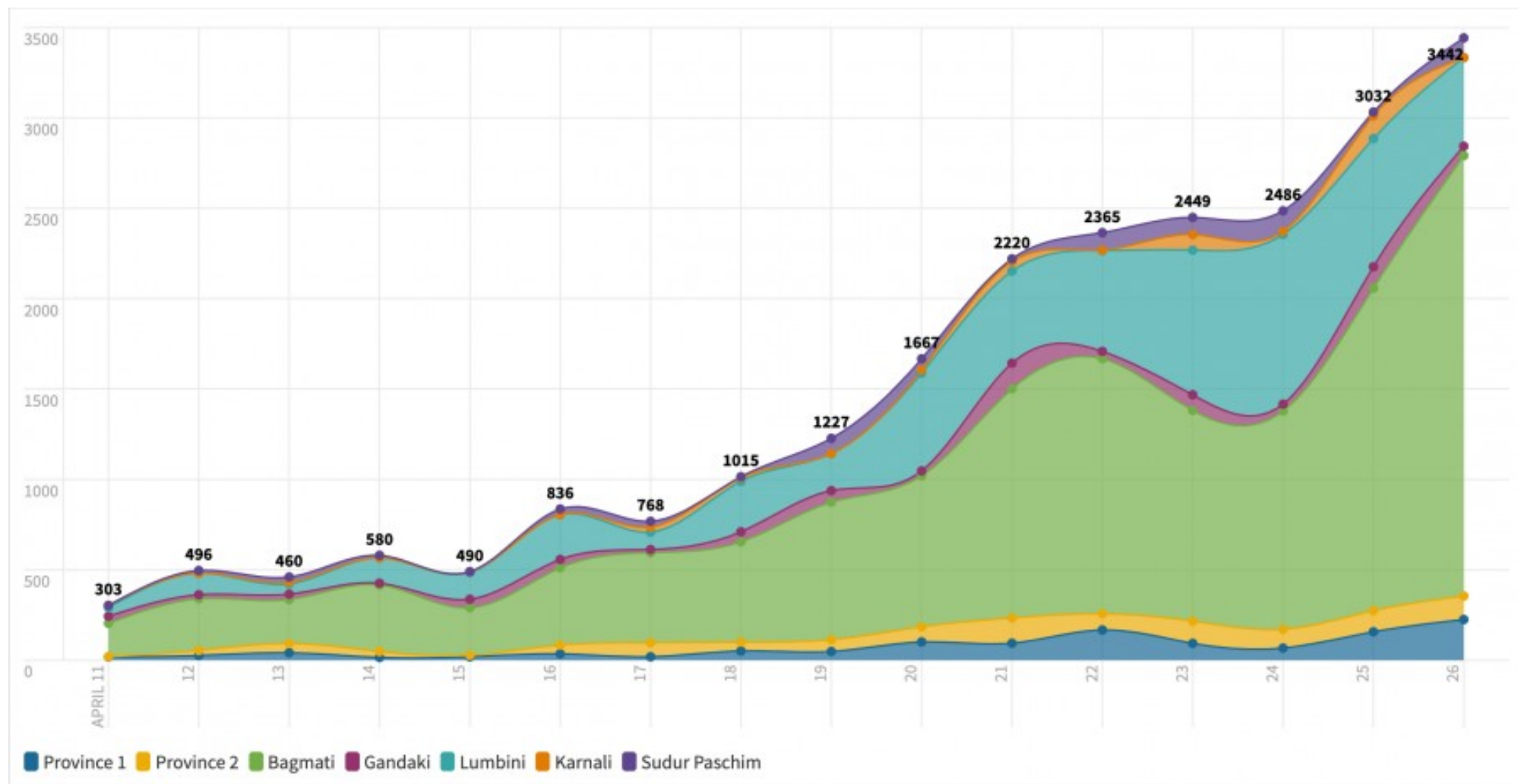

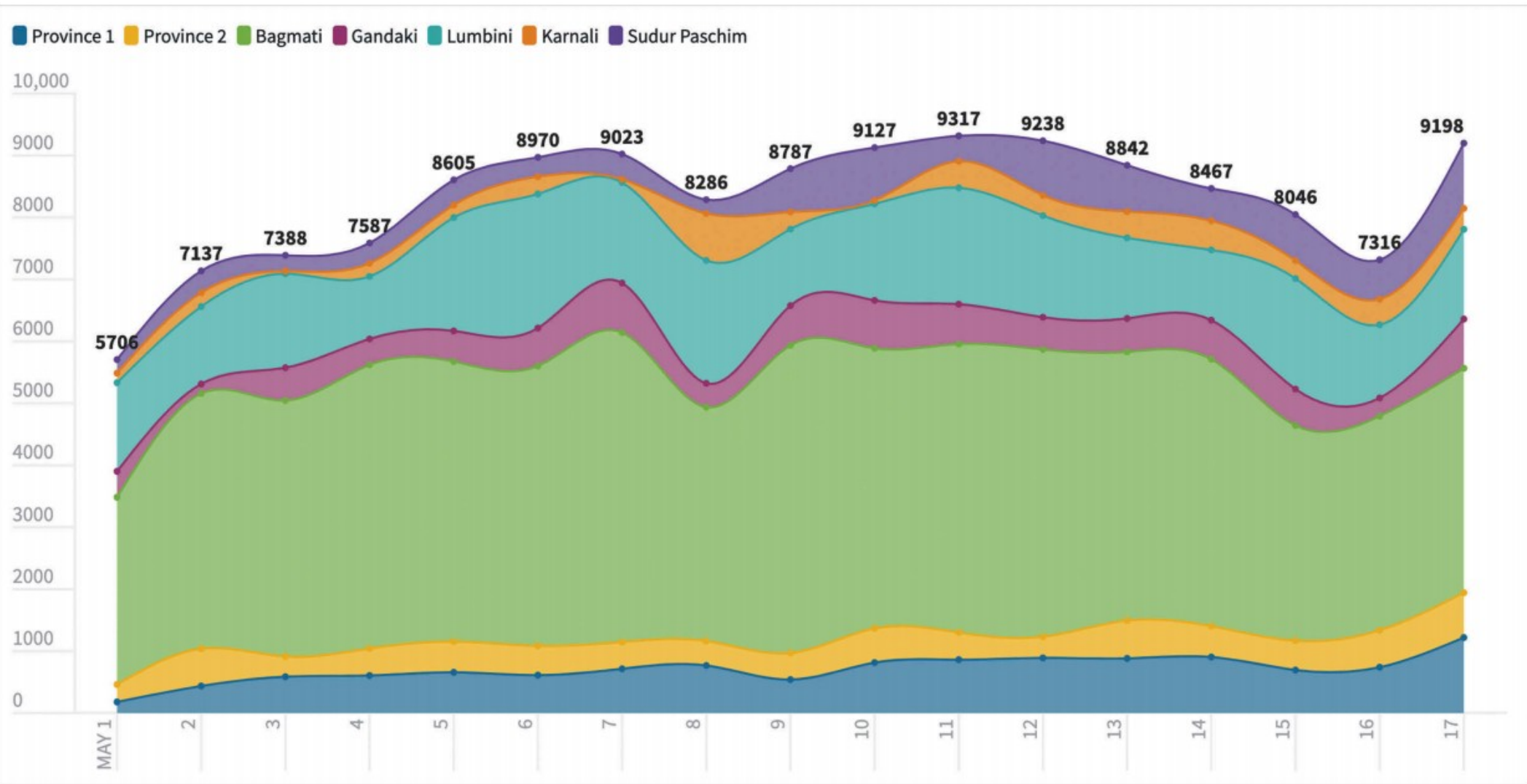

## Corona cases per provinces, May 2021



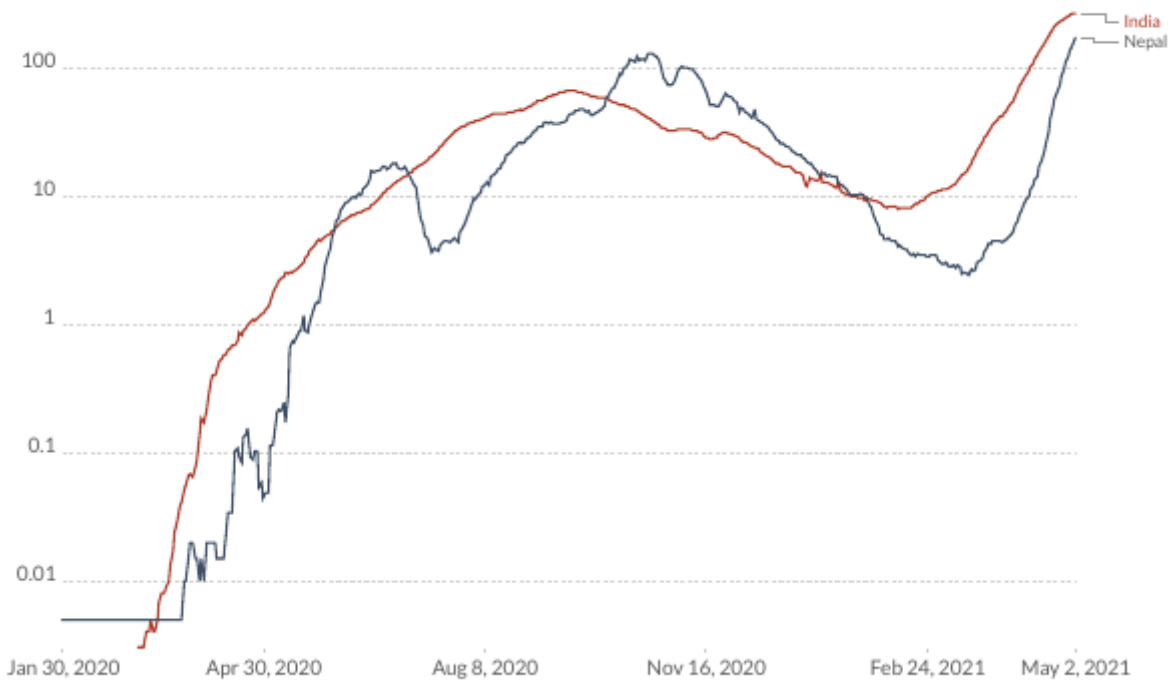

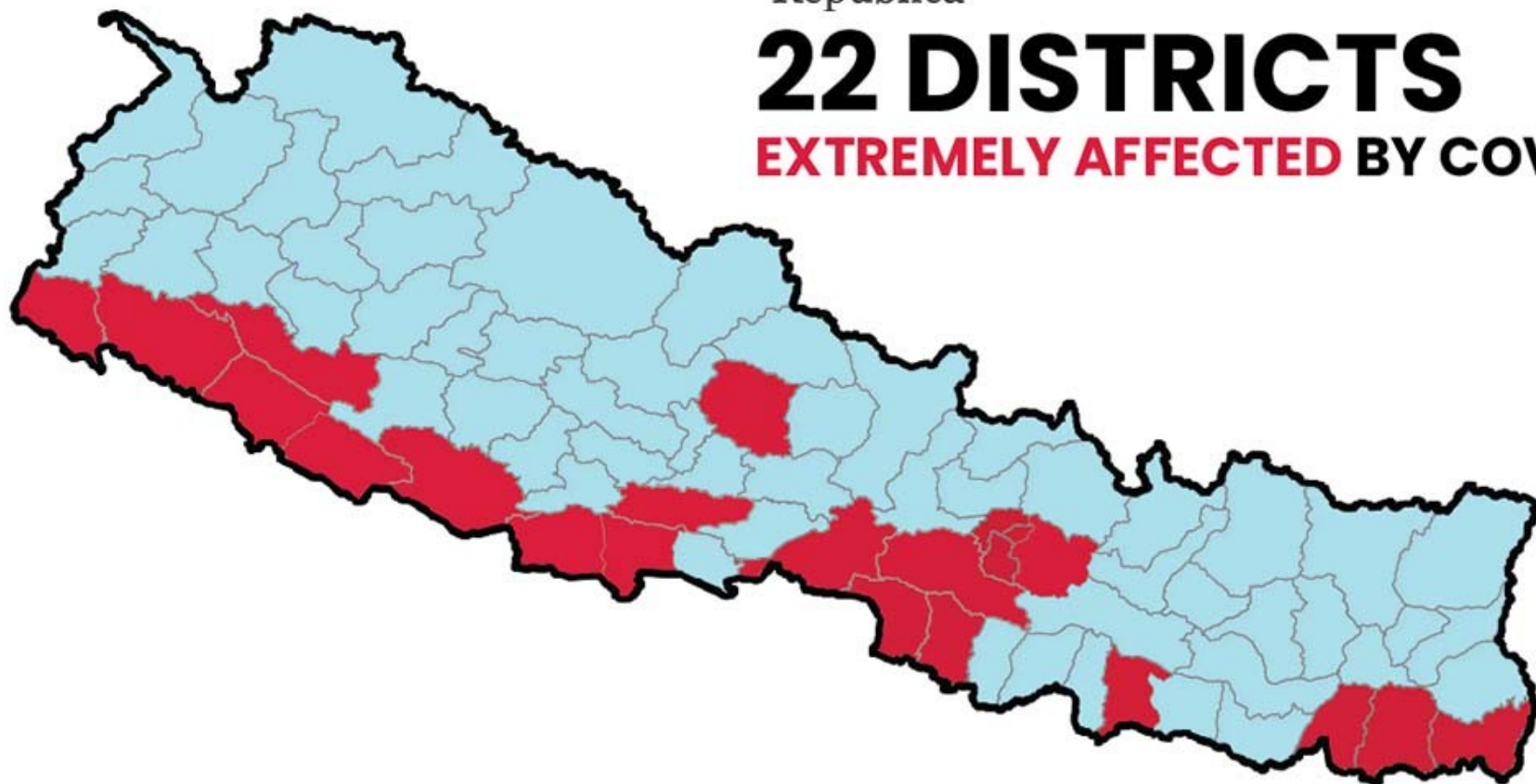

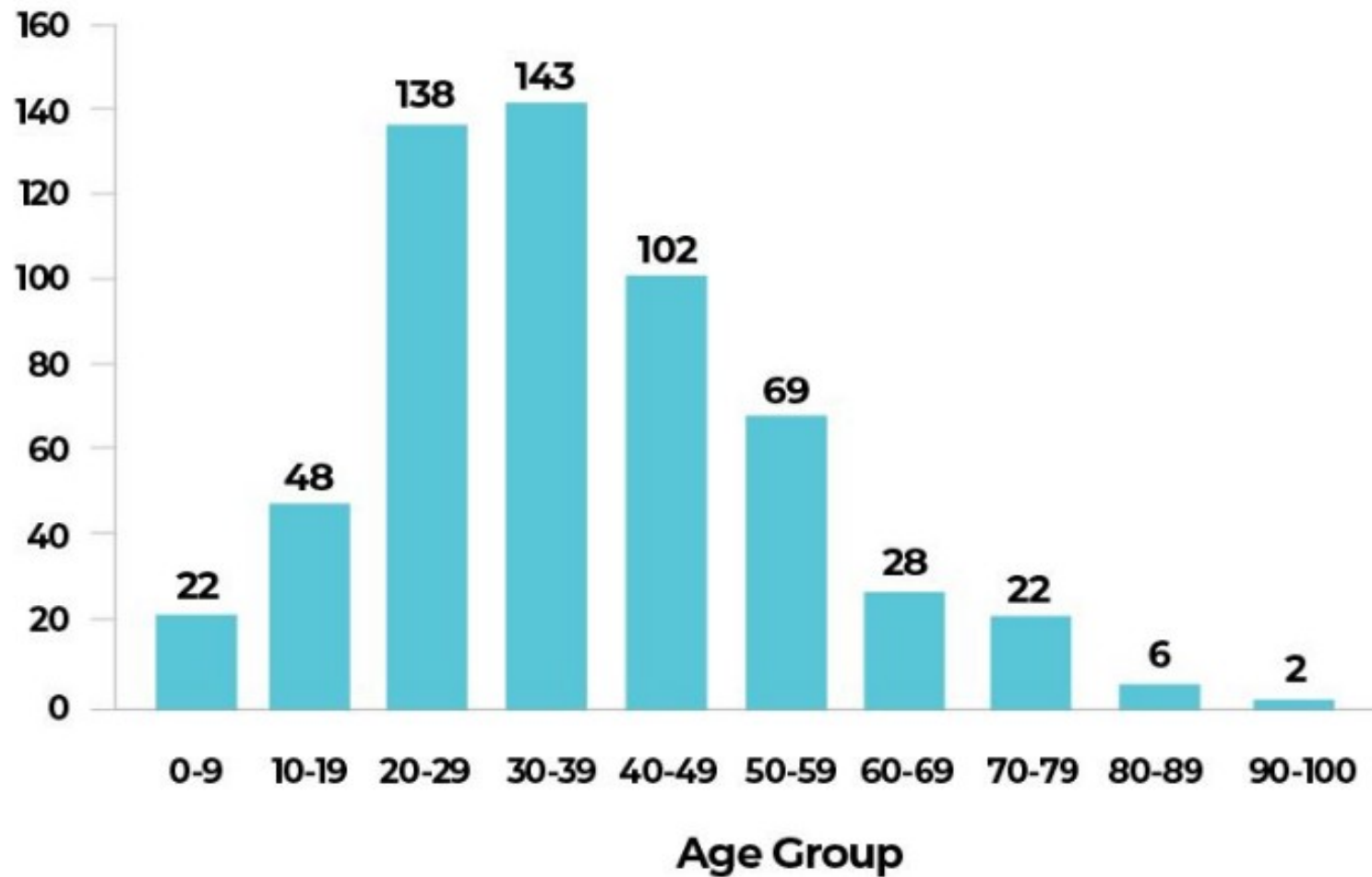

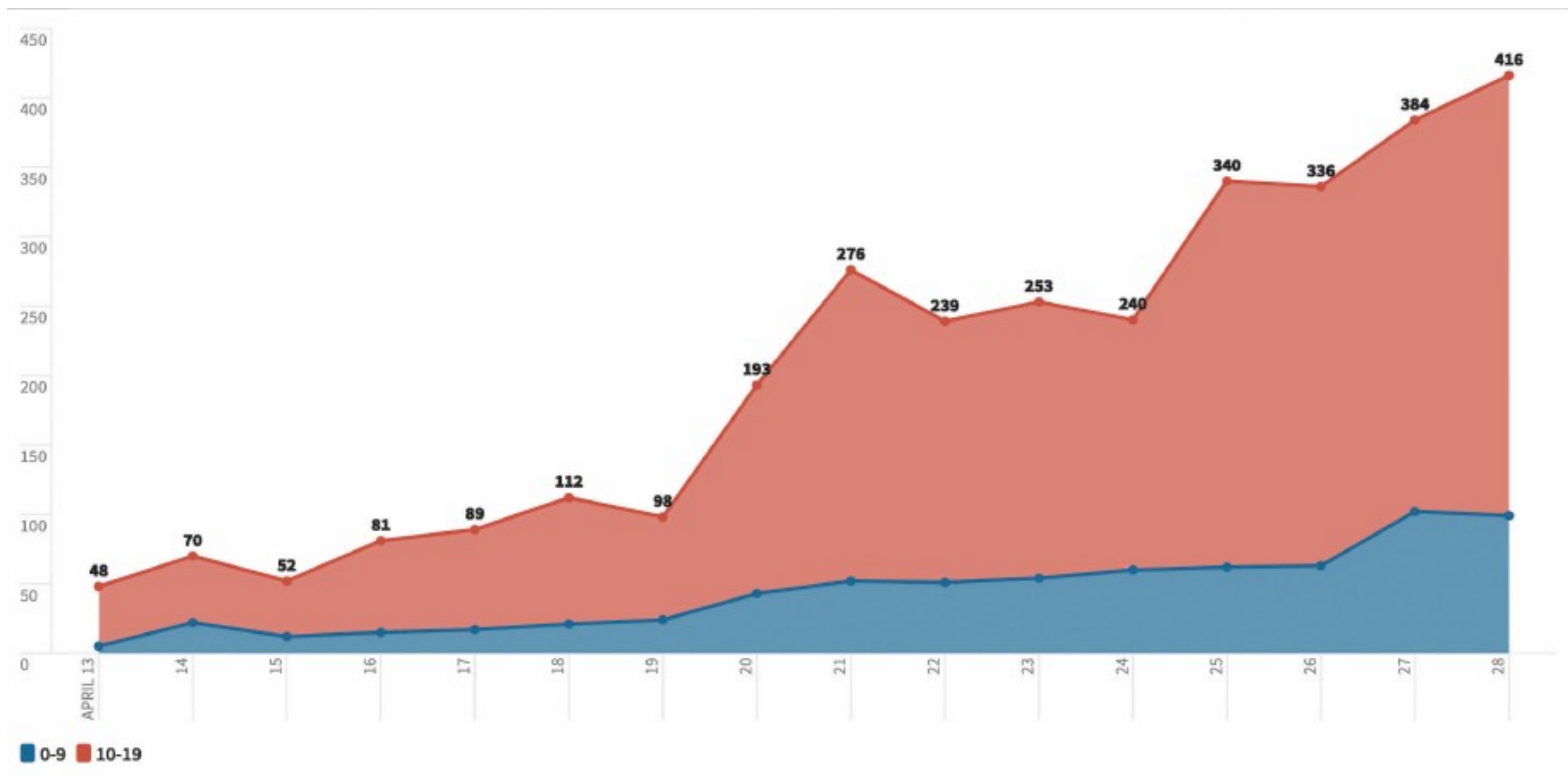


## Age of infected persons, 14 April 2021
