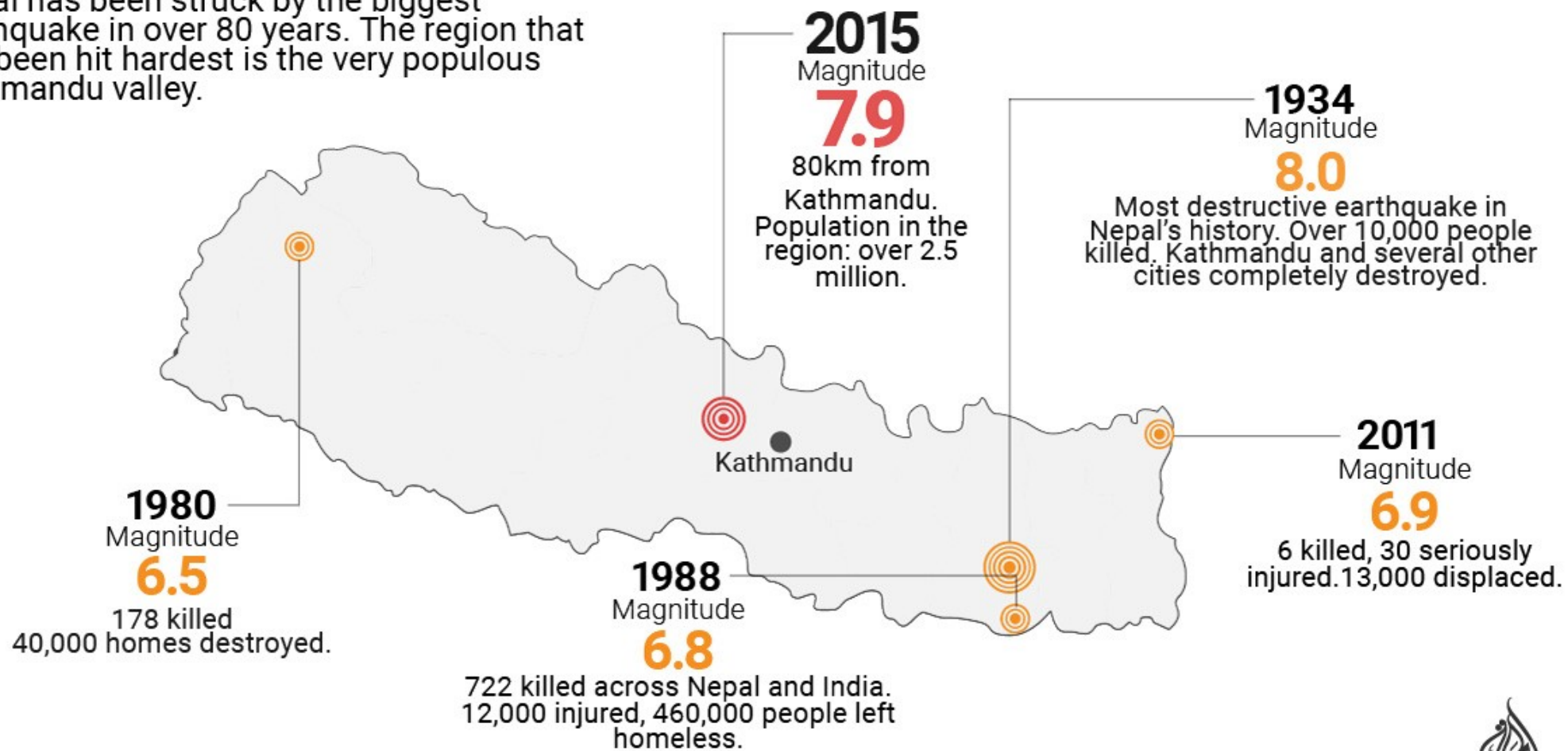


Danger of earthquakes

Nepal has been struck by the biggest earthquake in over 80 years. The region that has been hit hardest is the very populous Kathmandu valley.



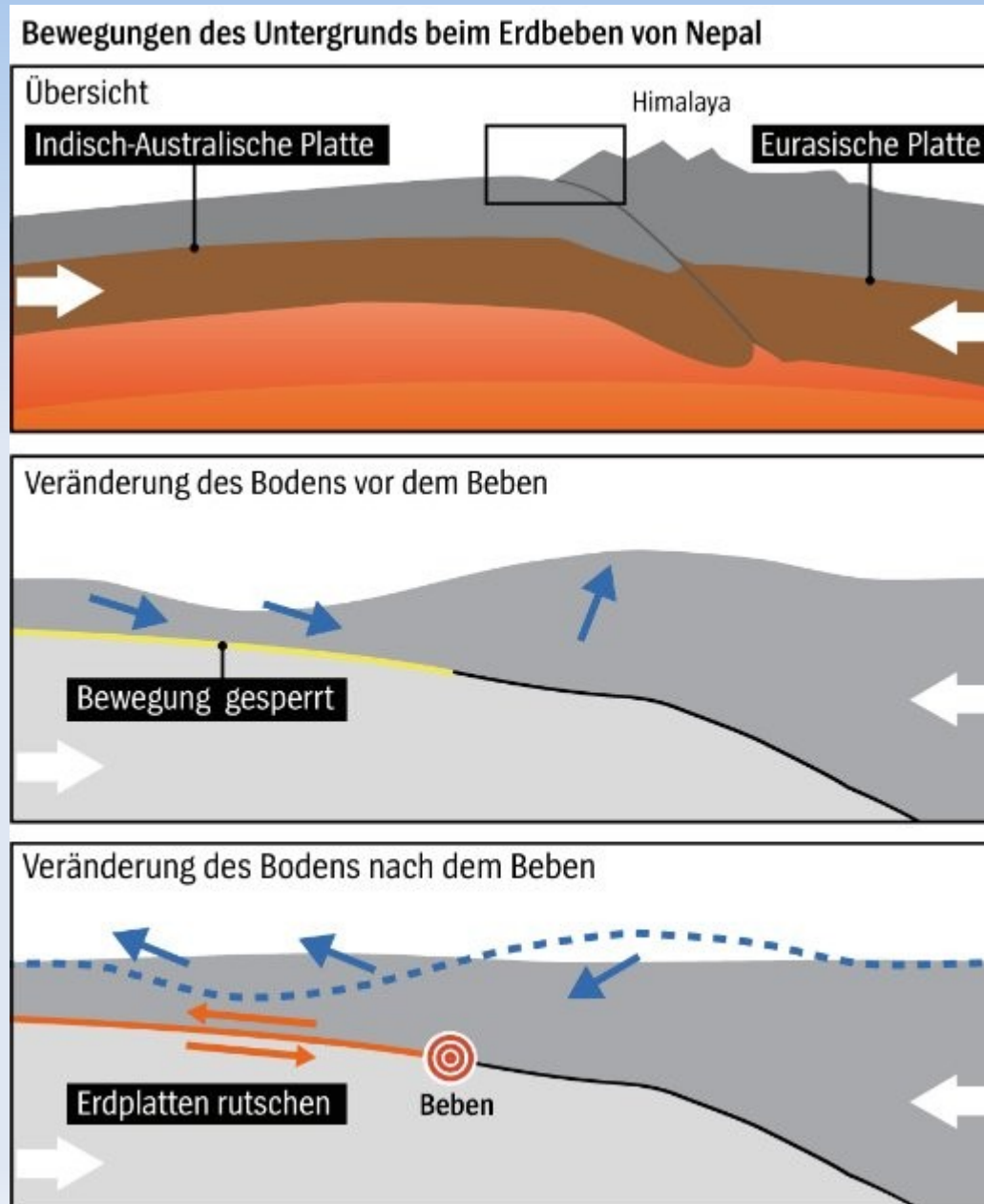

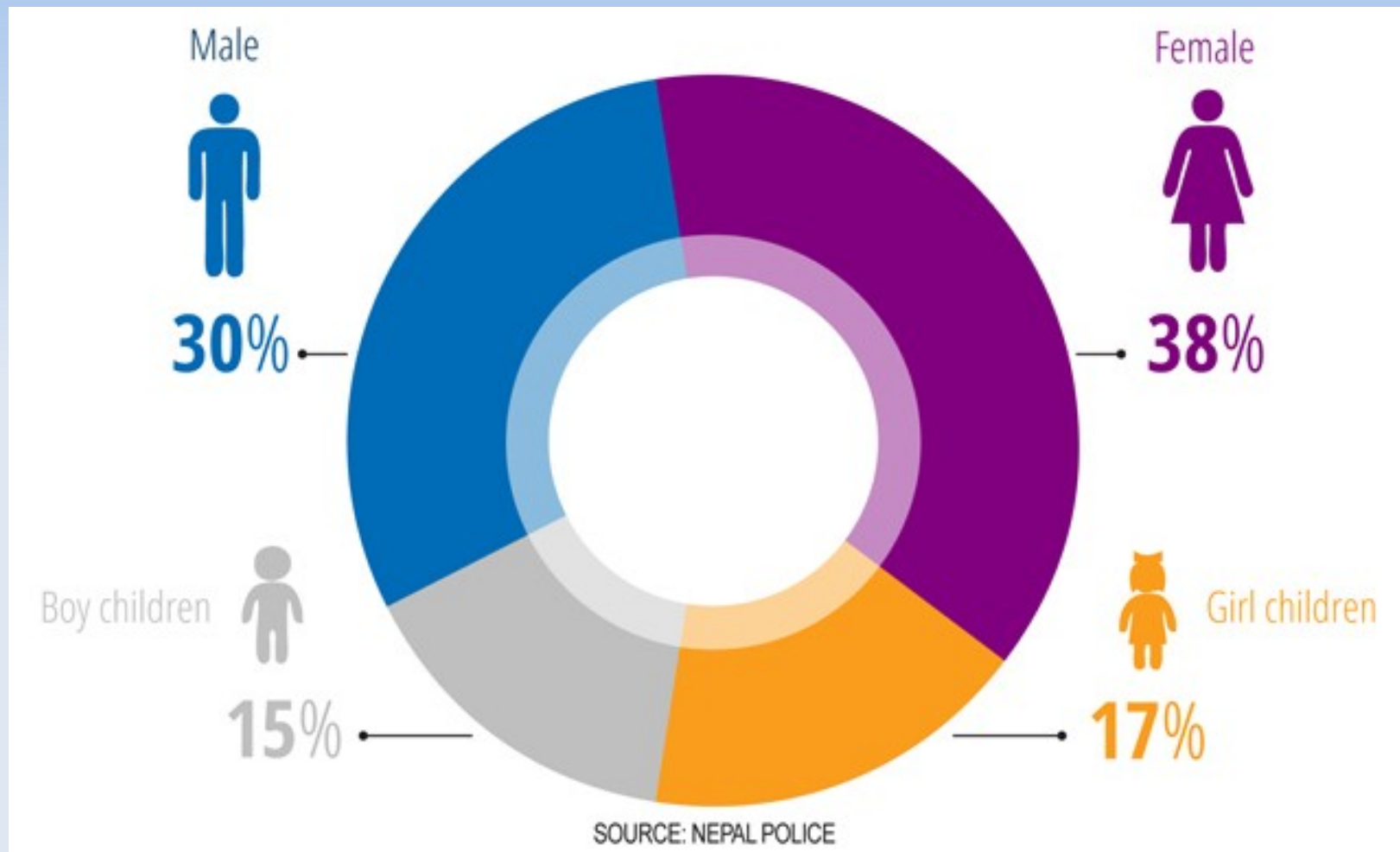
Earthquakes 2015 : elevation and depression



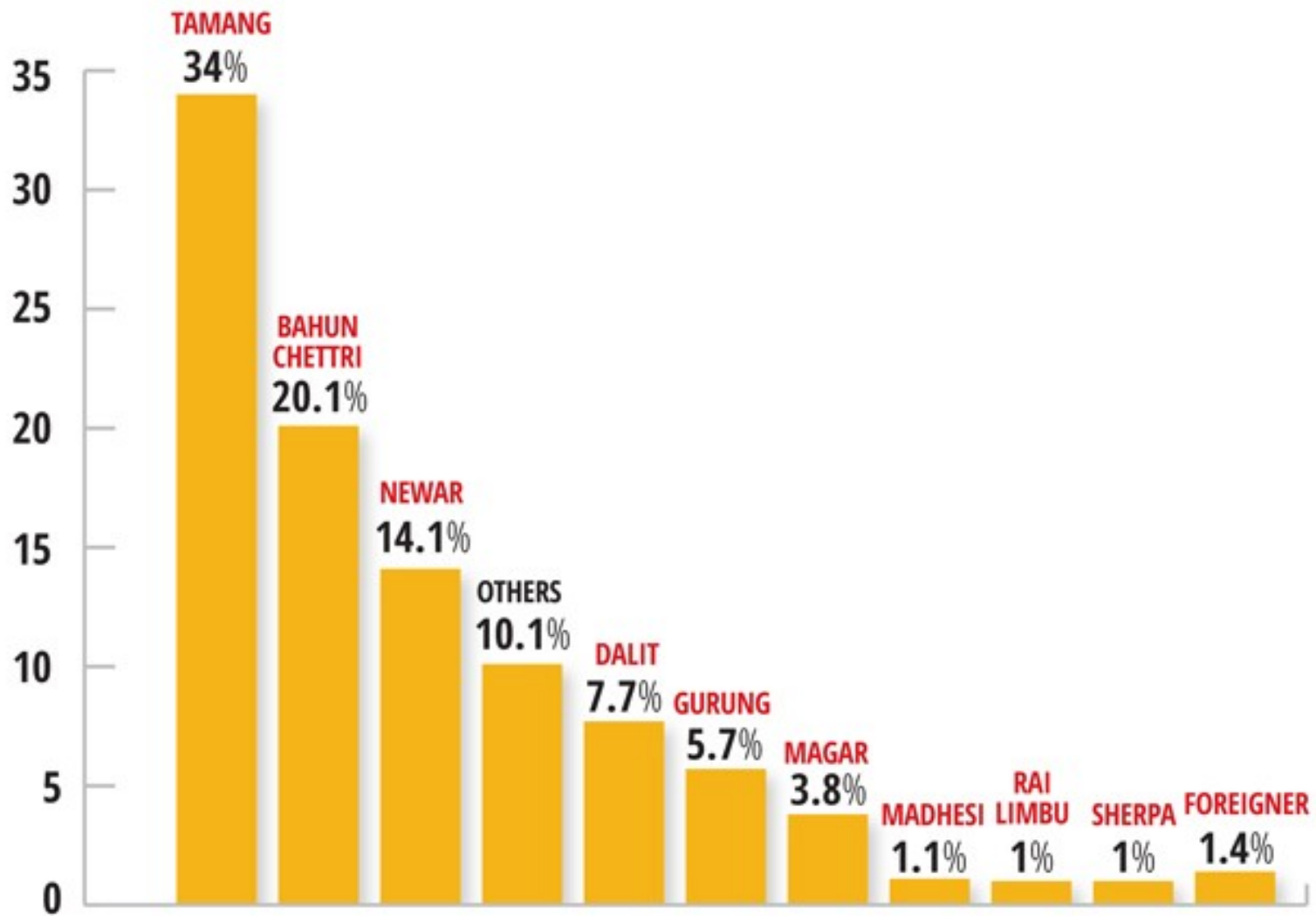
Earthquakes 2015 : most affected districts



Earthquakes 2015 : deaths/gender



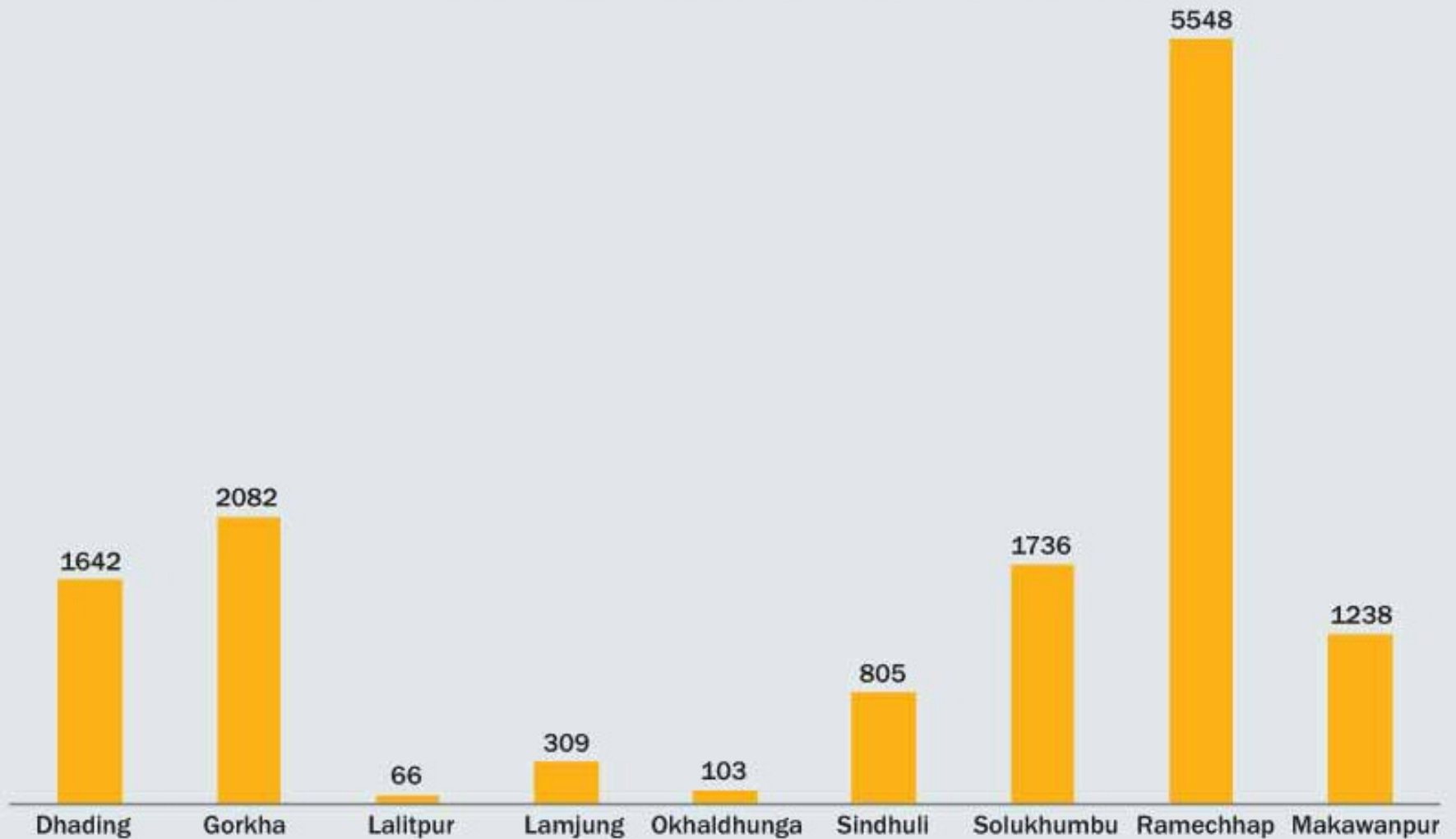
Earthquakes 2015 : deaths/ethnicity

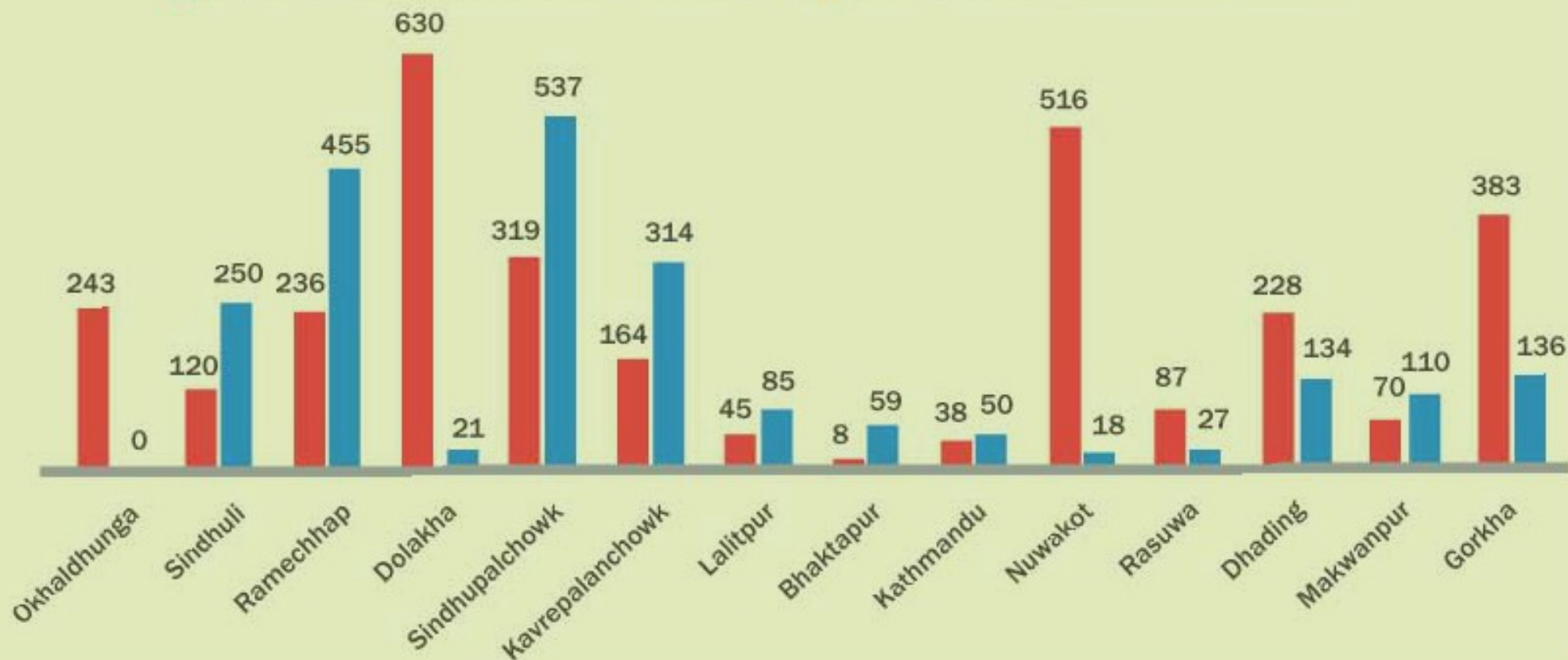
Households in need of relocation



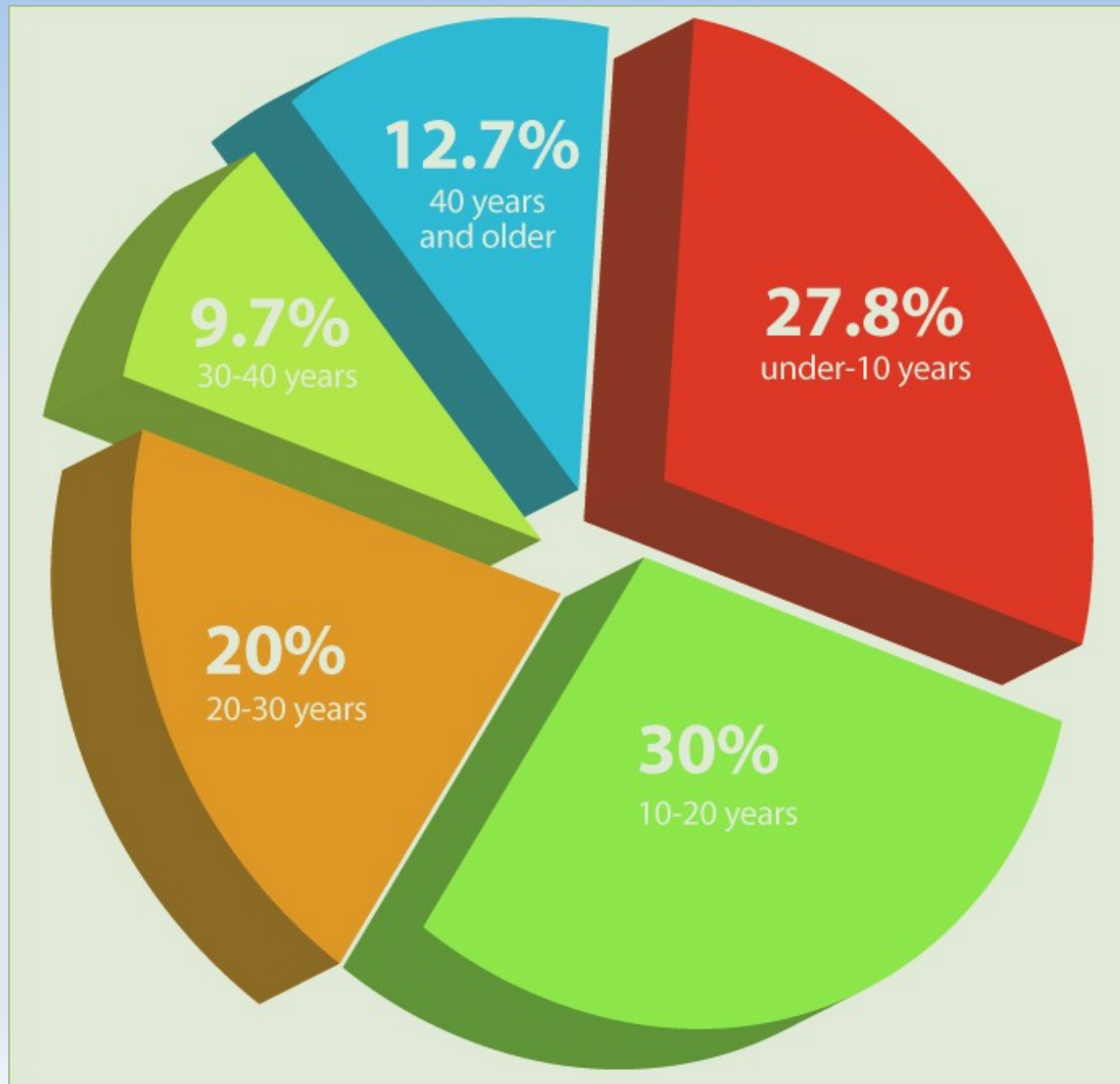
Earthquakes 2015 : dried water sources

Earthquakes 2015 : age of damaged houses

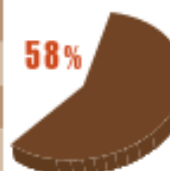

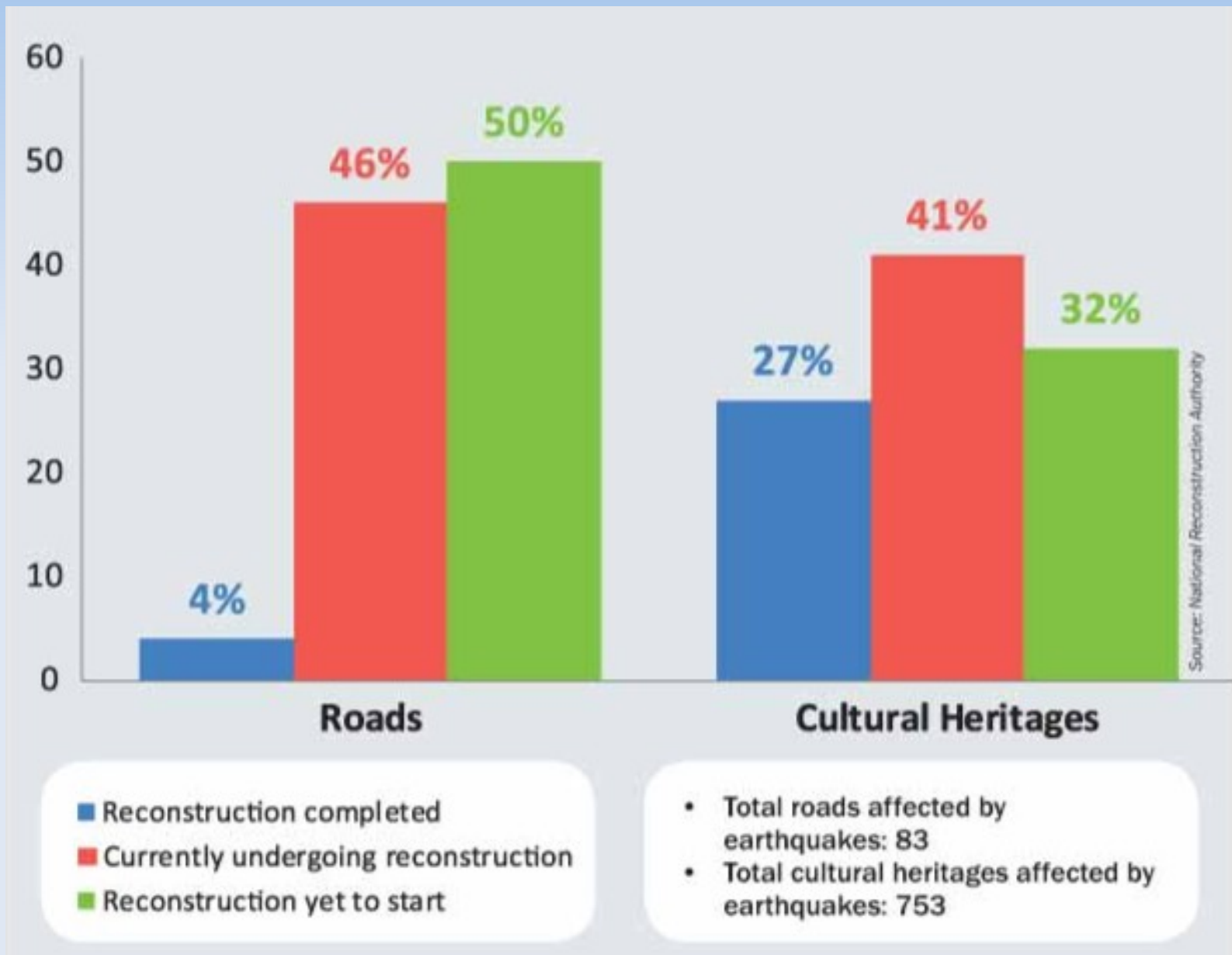
